
HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW TO SAFELY ENJOY THE PIERRE PART BELLE RIVER WATER TRAILS

RULES

- This property is managed by the Pierre Part Volunteer Fire Department. The dock is managed by the Assumption Parish Recreation District No. 2.
- Dock use hours are from dawn to dusk daily.
- Loitering, fishing from the dock or motorized boat docking are not allowed.
- The dock and surrounding areas are a Drug Free Zone with 24/7 video monitoring.
- No smoking, vaping or any tobacco products allowed.
- Beer and other alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the property.
- No vulgar or obscene language or fighting of any kind allowed at any time.
- Glass containers are not allowed on the property.
- The Parish Noise Ordinance must always be obeyed.
- Lifejackets are required. Bring a flare kit and an orange safety whistle.
- Follow all recreation boating rules enforced by the State of Louisiana.
- Rules are established and enforced by Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries (LADWF); Assumption Parish Sheriff's Office; and the Assumption Parish Recreation District No. 2.

TIPS FOR FUN AND SAFETY

- Each water trail is identified with a bird graphic and name. Signs indicating each mile along the trail can help you self-navigate your water adventure.
- Some kayak and canoe docks do not have lighting at night.
- Tell someone about your paddling plans before you leave.
- Always use personal flotation devices.
- Carry water and sunscreen: Louisiana can be hot & humid in summer months.
- Check weather conditions and be aware of current water conditions and flood stages.
- You may encounter crawfish traps, crab traps, float lines, and jug lines in the water. These are private property and should be respected and untouched.
- Occasionally you will see motorboats: remember to turn your bow into the wave.
- Park in designated areas making sure not to block driveways or interfere with traffic.
- Always be courteous to other river users. Follow the laws and rules of the area you are using.
- Look after the natural environment: avoid damaging the water banks and vegetation.
- Protect native species and habitats.
- Don't litter! Keep Louisiana Beautiful! Leave No Trace! And please take a few minutes to pick up litter left by others.
- Because cellular coverage may be limited, please photograph the maps and other information to take with you for safer travel along the Pierre Part Belle River Water Trails.
- Caution: always keep your distance from snakes and alligators!
